2008 RULES & REGULATIONS

POOL OPENING DATE: May 3, 2008
POOL CLOSING DATE: September 14, 2008

There will be life guards on duty the following days and during the following hours:

May 3 - June 7

Saturday - Sunday: 9am – 8pm
Monday - Friday: 4pm – 8pm
Memorial Day (May 28): 9am – 8pm

June 8 - August 24 (Wake County Schools out)

Saturday - Sunday: 9am – 8:30pm
Monday - Friday: 9am – 8:30pm
4th of July: 9am – 8:30pm

August 25 - September 14

(times of lifeguard coverage are subject to change due to Year Round schools)

Saturday - Sunday: 9am – 8:00pm
Monday - Friday: 4pm – 8:00pm
Labor Day (September 3): 9am – 8pm

You will have access to the pool from 7 a.m. – 8:00 or 8:30 p.m. everyday that the pool is open since all owners have an access card. Swim at your own risk during times when lifeguards are not on duty. The pool will also be closed during all scheduled home swim meets: June 17, July 1, and July 22, July 25 (these dates are subject to change).

Please note: There have been some changes to the rules- please read below

1. The pool is for the exclusive use of the property owners and their guests. Property owners will be responsible for all actions and conduct of their guests, and must accompany their guests when they use the pool. Should the guest policy become abused, the Board of Directors may restrict the number of guests allowed.
2. Two key access cards are given to each owner. All replacement cards are \$25.00 each.
3. There are lifeguards on duty at the pool but you may access the pool before they arrive. See hours above.
4. The pool may be closed at any time due either to a mechanical breakdown, weather conditions, or any other operational difficulty at the discretion of the Association. Prior notification of the pool closing is not required, although every effort will be made to do so when possible. A sign will be displayed at the entrance gate.
5. No glass is allowed within the fenced-in pool area. Both state and local laws dictate that no glass be brought into the pool area. Broken glass in the pool would result in pool closing for the required draining, cleaning, refilling and Health Department inspection. The person responsible will be billed the cost.
6. A shower is suggested before entering the pool.
7. In accordance with the Wake County Health Department, persons with open wounds, sores or skin infections are not permitted in the pool area. Persons with bandages or band-aids are not permitted in the pool.
8. Running, profanity, horseplay, improper conduct or any behavior that is potentially dangerous or offensive is not permitted. Any problems regarding inappropriate behavior should be reported to the pool manager immediately so proper action can be taken.
9. Everyone must clear the pool and/or deck when a storm is in the area. Swimmers must get out of the water at any sign of thunder and/or lightning.
10. Swimsuits are required for swimmers of all ages. "Cut-offs" are not permitted in the pool because loose strings can severely damage the pump and filter system.

11. No smoking is allowed inside the pool fenced in area.
12. No bicycles or skateboards are allowed in the pool area.
13. All children that are not 100% toilet trained are required to wear swim diapers or "little swimmers" and plastic pants. If you do not have plastic pants they can be purchased for a fee from the lifeguards while supplies last. No admittance in the pool area is allowed without plastic pants. If the pool becomes contaminated by human waste, an incident report will be filed and a copy sent to the homeowner. Those in violation of the rules will not be allowed admittance.
14. An adult must accompany children under 13 years of age.
15. Diving from the edge of the pool is prohibited. The diving blocks are only for the use of the swim team during swim meets and practices.
16. Radios may be used only if they are played at low volume. Please be considerate of others.
17. Management and the Board reserve the right to deny use of the pool to anyone at any time.
18. A ten (10) minute break will be taken by the lifeguards every hour. No one under the age of 16 is allowed to swim during break time.
19. Should you wish to use the pool area for a party, a form needs to be filled out and given to the manger or asst. manger at the pool (see form attached). Pool forms are not to be faxed or mailed. The pool needs to be reserved at least one week prior to the party. It is the responsibility of the host to verify the pool and lifeguard availability on the party date with the pool manager. Please clean up any debris created by your use before leaving and return all pool furniture to its proper place. Obey all pool rules and be considerate of others while using the pool. Managers and asst. mgrs will reserve the gas grills and shelter sfor those having a party. The gas grill is to be cleaned after each use. It is not the lifeguards' responsibility to clean up after a gathering; please keep this in mind.
20. If a house is being rented, the homeowner gives up their recreation membership rights to that of the renter.
21. On Monday, Tuesday, Thursday evenings from 6:00-8:30 pm and Saturday mornings from 9:00-11:00 am the swim lanes will be used for swim team practice and that area of the pool will be closed. The 3' and splash pool will remain open to the public. During swim meets all pool areas will close at 5:00 pm.
